

Explanation REACH / RoHS / Prohibited Substances

1. Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH)

The company AQUAtec Master in Metal GmbH is not subject to your customers' obligation to inform under Article 33 of the REACH Regulation if a product supplied by us contains a substance of very high concern (SVHC substance) in a mass concentration above 0.1%.

To this day, we have no knowledge that the products supplied to you contain SVHC substances in concentrations above 0.1% by weight. If SVHC substances are present in our products above the stated mass concentration, we will inform you immediately.

2. EU Directive RoHS (2011/65 / EU formerly 2002/95 / EC)

With regard to the fulfillment of the requirements of EU Directive 2011/65 / EU ("RoHS", formerly 2002/95/EC), we would like to inform you that their substance bans are currently not applicable to our products. Our products are not subject to the categories of Directive 2011/65/EU listed in Annex I.

Nevertheless, we strive to meet the requirements of the above-mentioned directive on the absence of harmful substances at the earliest possible point in time. For this reason, AQUAtec Master in Metal GmbH has set up a comprehensive program that prevents the use of environmentally hazardous substances in our products at the earliest possible date.

In addition, the AQUAtec Master in Metal GmbH carries out extensive regular investigations in order to identify substances harmful to health or the environment and to eliminate them as far as possible in the context of substitution tests. This is also part of our established continuous improvement program as part of our ISO 14001 certification.
